This object is understood to include the following among its activities: -The holding of regular prayer meetings and worship services -Evangelism in the community -Discipling believers to become fully devoted followers of Jesus -Conducting youth programs for church members and of the community -Seeking the spiritual welfare of the communities in west London -Doing deeds of mercy for the general welfare of the communities of west London Supporting the missionary work of other churches, denominations, and mission agencies

Summary of the charity's main activities and achievements

To further the above objects and vision, the charity's main activities and achievements were as follows:

Over 2024, New Life Masih Ghar (NLMG) gathered for corporate worship every Sunday in 2024.

2024 saw the change of worship locations from Heston Methodist Church on Heston Road to a new location at St. Mary's Church of England Primary School in Norwood Green. this move enabled NLMG to move worship times to 10am on Sunday mornings.

Twice Weekly Women's Bible studies were held in 2024. Both times saw an increase in participants over the course of the year.

Men's Bible study took place fortnightly.

Community Outreach programs continued in 2024, Parent and Tots, Heston Kid's Club, Coffee & Tea Fellowship, Book Tables, and Heston Youth Club. All activities were warmly received and well attended.

In planning the activities, the trustees have applied the guidance on public benefit issued by the Charity Commission.
