Independent Examination for Year Ended 31 August 2025

As requested, I have carried out a review of Friends of Christ the King Fundraising Group accounts for the year ended 31 August 2025. As stated at the end of last year, the accounts now include the bank balances transferred from Christ the King FR Group. I can confirm the following:

- The cheque book, bank statement and items indicated as cheque payment in the cashbook all balanced.
- All net cash recorded in the event income and expenditure accounts is correctly recorded in the cashbook and has subsequently been paid into the bank account held at Barclays Bank.
- All sumup card transactions have been correctly recorded.
- All receipted expenditure has been correctly recorded.
- All interest has been correctly recorded in the cashbook.
- All monthly lottery subscriptions have been received in the bank account at Nat West and have been correctly recorded in the cashbook.
