The Trustees present their report and accounts for the year ended 31 March 2022. The Trustees have adopted the provisions of the Statement of Recommended Practice (SORP) Accounting and Reporting by Charities'.

Structure, governance and management.

The Charity was registered under the Charities Act on 18 July 2003 and given the number 1098646. The Charity's governing document is the constitution adopted 29 June 2013 as amended 19 October 2003

The Trustees of the Church are the pastor and deacons appointed by the Church members at an Annual General Meeting. Their appointment is for life unless they voluntarily withdraw or are removed from the office by the Church.

The pastor and the deacons meet on a formal basis throughout the year as they deem necessary to fulfil their obligations as trustees and to ensure the smooth running of the Church and the Charity.

Objectives and activities

The Charity aims to advance the Christian faith by teaching, preaching and propagating the doctrines, principles and beliefs and teaching of God and our Lord Jesus Christ in accordance with the bible.

Achievements and performance

Bury Bible Baptist Church has remained faithful to its Articles of Faith. Church services are held every Sunday morning with a Sunday School being available.

Thursday evening prayer meeting and bible study continues and throughout the year various special service and activities are held.

Overseas missionaries have continued to be supported both financially and with prayer.
