Light for the Last Days was constituted as a charitable trust in April 2003 for the purpose of advancing the Christian faith.


During 2024 we continued to produce the magazine Light for the Last Days. 10,000 copies are printed four times a year and sent out to people on our mailing list. Copies are also distributed by those using them in evangelism or at public meetings. The magazine is also distributed online. We produce leaflets and booklets on the Bible and prophecy which are distributed through our members. We have seen an increase in the number of people from the mailing list taking these leaflets for distribution.

Our website is [www.lightforthelastdays.co.uk](http://www.lightforthelastdays.co.uk). This is visited by people from around the world and contains articles on Bible teaching and current issues and events. It also contains the magazine. We have also produced a regular Prophecy Update, 'The Month in Prophecy' which is recorded on the last Sunday of the month at The Bridge Christian Fellowship and distributed via our website and the Bridge website ([www.bridgelane.org.uk](http://www.bridgelane.org.uk)).

The magazine is translated into French, German, Romanian, Spanish, Chinese and the Indian language, Malayalam. Due to the high costs of printing and postage we are now only producing it in French, Spanish and Chinese online. These are translated by Eric Martinez. The other languages are translated and produced by our associates, Cornelia Kuruc in Switzerland who produces the German edition, Ligia Luca in Romania and Rev Pappy Daniel in India. We now have a contact in Pakistan, Rev Shahzad Waqar, who is translating and distributing some of our material into Urdu. We have also supplied materials and funds for help in the work of Frazer Nauliya in Malawi.

Eric Martinez continues to look after our online platform and social media sites. Through this we are reaching out to people in many countries of the world, especially in Africa and the Indian subcontinent.

Financial support for the charity comes from subscriptions and free will gifts from those on our mailing list. A number of people give regularly to the work under our Gift Aid scheme. We continue to use our resources to produce and distribute the magazine and leaflets which contain Christian news and views about current world events in the light of Bible prophecy and teaching on the meaning of the Bible. All of this is available to the general public.

## Light for the Last Days

### Independent Examiner's Report to the Trustees of Light for the Last Days

I report on the accounts of the Trust for the year ended 31 December 2024.

#### Respective responsibilities of trustees and examiner

The Charity's trustees are responsible for the preparation of the accounts. The Charity's trustees consider that an audit is not required for this year under section 144(2) of the Charities Act 2011 (the 2011 Act) and that an independent examination is needed.

It is my responsibility to:

- examine the accounts under section 145 of the 2011 Act
- follow the procedures laid down in the general Directions given by the Charity Commission under section 145(5)(b) of the 2011 Act
- state whether particular matters have come to my attention

#### Basis of independent examiner's report

My examination was carried out in accordance with the general Directions given by the Charity Commission. An examination includes a review of the accounting records kept by the charity and a comparison of the accounts presented with those records. It also includes consideration of any unusual items or disclosures in the accounts, and seeking explanations from you as trustees concerning any such matters. The procedures undertaken do not provide all the evidence that would be required in an audit and consequently no opinion is given as to whether the accounts present a 'true and fair view' and the report is limited to those matters set out in the next statement.
