Objects: (A) TO ADVANCE THE CHRISTIAN RELIGION BY THE PRESERVATION REPAIR MAINTENANCE IMPROVEMENT AND BEAUTIFICATION OF THE CHURCH OF ST PETER'S REVELSTOKE ("THE CHURCH") IN THE DIOCESE OF EXETER AND THE COUNTY OF DEVON AND OF THE MONUMENTS FITTING FIXTURES STAINED GLASS FURNITURE ORNAMENTS AND CHATTELS IN THE CHURCH AND OF THE CHURCHYARD BELONGING TO THE CHURCH;(B) FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE PEOPLE OF THE SAID COUNTY OF DEVON AND THE SAID DIOCESE TO PRESERVE REPAIR MAINTAIN IMPROVE BEAUTIFY AND RECONSTRUCT THE CHURCH AS A BUILDING OF HISTORICAL IMPORTANCE OR ARCHITECTURAL VALUE IN THE EVENT OF THE CHURCH BEING DECLARED REDUNDANT BY A PASTORAL SCHEME MADE UNDER THE PASTORAL MEASURE 1983 (OR ANY STATUTORY MODIFICATION OR RE-ENACTMENT THEREOF) OR OTHERWISE CEASING TO BE USED REGULARLY FOR PUBLIC WORSHIP AND THE MONUMENTS FITTINGS FIXTURES STAINED GLASS FURNITURE ORNAMENTS AND CHATTELS IN THE CHURCH AND THE CHURCHYARD BELONGING THERETO.

Activities: Preserve repair maintenance improvement and beautification of the church of St Peters Revelstoke and of the monuments fittings and chattels in the church and of the churchyard belonging to the church.To preserve repair maintain beautify and reconstruct the church as a building of historical importance or architectural value in the event of the church being declared redundant.





The sum of £80000 was transferred to deposit with the Church of England to obtain an improved rate of interest which has been added to make **£80364.11**.

Report to St Peter Revelstoke PCC

Noss Mayo Church Heritage Trust for the year to 31st December 2023.

The accounts of the Trust are with this report. They follow on logically from last year with the focus being on the structural repairs needed on the tower.

We received a further generous distribution from the Estate of the wife of Revd Fairbrother. It should be remembered that Revd Fairbrother was very fond of the community of St Peter and the support he received from Garth and Sue Mumford in very difficult times.


We have been generously supported by the Revelstoke Community Trust and received a donation from Devon Historic Churches Trust. The Parish Magazine distribution represents two years.

On the expenses side, it is mainly the start of work on the tower with the usual professional fees associated with this type of work. All the render has been taken off the inside of the tower to reveal the stonework.

It is not all bad news. Work will need to be undertaken but not as urgently as we first thought. It will be able to be spread over few years and perhaps give us the time to raise the money necessary. Our next stage will require a further faculty when we are advised on the next step which will require scaffold to repoint and insert steel bonding. Then of course while the scaffold is up do we re-enamel the clock faces?

Additionally, it is the year for our Quinquennial Inspection. We do review the current Report on a regular basis and we have addressed some items which are listed as the tower work has progressed.

As ever, we keep Faith and are assured the Good Lord will help provide!

Accounts

Report to St Peter Revelstoke PCC

Noss Mayo Church Heritage Trust for the year to 31st December 2022.

The accounts of the Trust are with this report. They need little explanation as there only very few transactions.

The receipts this year are in the main, the generous donations in memory of Garth Mumford whom you all know was a mainstay of this church for many, many years. His knowledge and memory is already missed. In his time the church ran smoothly without fuss because Garth was conducting much, very quietly from the undercroft! Additionally we received a very generous bequest on the death of the wife of Revd Fairbrother. It was he who in his time created our Resurrection chapel and was very fond of the community of St Peter and the support received from Garth.

On the expenses side, we replaced the old part of the vestry floor which was as weak as walking on paper!

The other major amount paid out was for Architects fees in connection with the start of the tower repairs. There will be many more. .As you know this is a major project on which we are embarking and a fund- raising campaign will be necessary. At time of writing, we have received the first Faculty to enable us to remove all the rendering on the inside of the tower. This will reveal exactly what is involved in the project.

Additionally the trustees visit our Quinquennial Report on a regular basis and we address those items which are listed as most urgent. There are many, many items listed but that is the nature of these reports!
