# Independent Examiner's Report

## Independent Examiner's Report to the Trustees of The Friends of Gads Hill School (Registered charity number: 1100033)

Year ended 31 July 2025

### Respective responsibilities of trustees and examiner

The charity's trustees are responsible for the preparation of the accounts in accordance with the requirements of the Charities Act 2011 and the Charity Commission's guidance. They consider that an audit is not required for this year under section 144(2) of the Charities Act 2011 and that an independent examination is needed. My responsibility is to conduct an independent examination in accordance with section 145 of the Charities Act 2011 and the Charity Commission's guidance CC32, and to report to you on the accounts.

### Basis of independent examiner's statement

My examination was carried out in accordance with CC32: Directions and guidance for independent examiners issued by the Charity Commission. An examination includes a review of the accounting records kept by the charity and a comparison of the accounts presented with those records.
