As the Auditors of the Hebron Apostolic and prophetic church we have critically examined the information and explanations given by the Directors and Finance committee. We have carried out tests of details of the transactions and balances, review of minutes of directors meetings and have questioned for uncertainty.

In our opinion the judgments made by the directors and accounting policies applied are acceptable. All the policies and procedures for internal controls adapted by the Directors and Finance committee assist in achieving their objective of ensuring the orderly and efficient conduct of the organization, including adherence to internal policies, the safeguarding of the assets, the prevention and detection of fraud and error, the accuracy and competences of the accounting records and the preparation of reliable information.
