2. Structure, Governance and Management

The charity is governed by a board of trustees responsible for ensuring that the organisation operates in accordance with its charitable objectives and relevant regulatory requirements. Trustees meet periodically to review strategy, financial management, and operational matters.

Trustees serve on a voluntary basis and receive no remuneration. Governance arrangements are guided by principles of transparency, accountability, and responsible stewardship of charitable resources.

3. Objectives and Charitable Purpose

The objective of Madrasatunnur Educational Trust is to advance education and promote religious understanding within the community. The charity aims to provide structured learning opportunities, facilitate communal worship, and support community welfare initiatives.

In planning its activities, the trustees have considered the Charity Commission guidance on public benefit and are satisfied that the charity's work contributes positively to the wider community.

4. Activities During the Year

Weekend Madrasah

The charity operates a Weekend Madrasah programme providing children and young people with structured Islamic education including Qur'an recitation, Islamic studies, and moral guidance.

Friday Congregational Prayers

The charity facilitates weekly Friday prayers for members of the community, providing a space for collective worship and religious guidance.

Funeral Support Scheme

A community-based funeral support scheme has been developed to assist families with burial arrangements and associated costs in accordance with Islamic principles.

Nikkah Services

The charity also facilitates Islamic marriage ceremonies while providing guidance on procedural requirements and family responsibilities.

5. Achievements and Community Impact

The charity continues to provide educational opportunities and religious services to the community. The Weekend Madrasah has supported children in gaining Islamic knowledge while promoting moral and ethical values.

Friday congregational prayers have strengthened community engagement and spiritual reflection. The funeral support scheme has provided reassurance and support to families during times of bereavement.

6. Community Centre Development Project

The trustees are actively pursuing the long-term objective of acquiring a permanent community centre. This facility would provide a dedicated space for educational programmes, congregational worship, youth development initiatives, and wider community services.

The charity continues to engage supporters through fundraising campaigns and community initiatives. Updates regarding this project are shared through the organisation's website.
