## **Report of the Trustees**

**For the year ended 30th June 2024**

The trustees present their report and financial statements for the year ended 30th June 2024.

### **Review of the business**

The day-to-day business is controlled by the Council who meet periodically.

During the year, a very successful fund raising golf day and a bike ride were held which generated net funds of £29,070 and £22,363 respectively for the charity. In addition, generous donations of £75,800 was received from members of the public and £7,000 from our trustees. Donations of £122,519 were made towards research and alleviation of children's illnesses and welfare, principally to Great Ormond Street Hospital, SCT Bone Cancer Trust, Spread A Smile and Playskill.

### **Financial review**

The results for the year are set out on page 5. The Financial Statements have been prepared in accordance with the Statement of Recommended Accounting Practice and Reporting by Charities, published in March 2005, with the aim of presenting a true and fair view of the financial position of the charity.

During the year, funds were generated from donations received, bank interest received and the fund raising activity. At the balance sheet date there is £142,839 cash at bank which continue to generate income.


### **Trustees**


