- Sent funds to support the improvement of students' education
- Supported agricultural development to provide food for Karen students and their families
- Assisted single homeless mothers and their babies with accommodation, education and welfare
- Provided aid to internally displaced Karen people on the Thai–Myanmar border
- Supplied medical supplies to victims of the earthquake in Myanmar

The trustees believe these activities have had a positive impact on the individuals and communities supported.

Plans for future periods


The trustees intend to continue supporting education, welfare and humanitarian aid projects in line with the charity's objectives, subject to available funds.
