Income – Successes

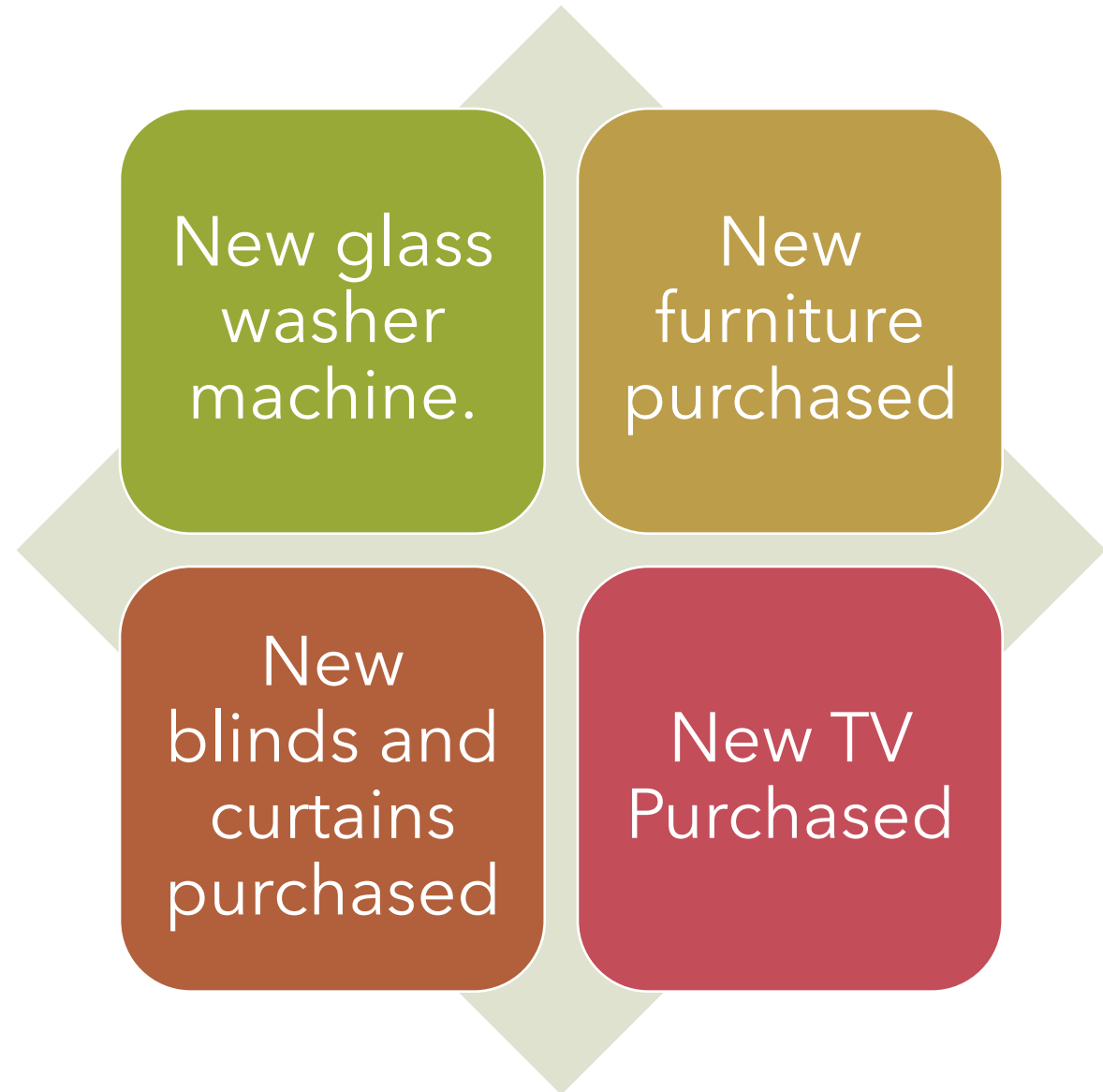
- Contribution from Social Club increased by £22070.

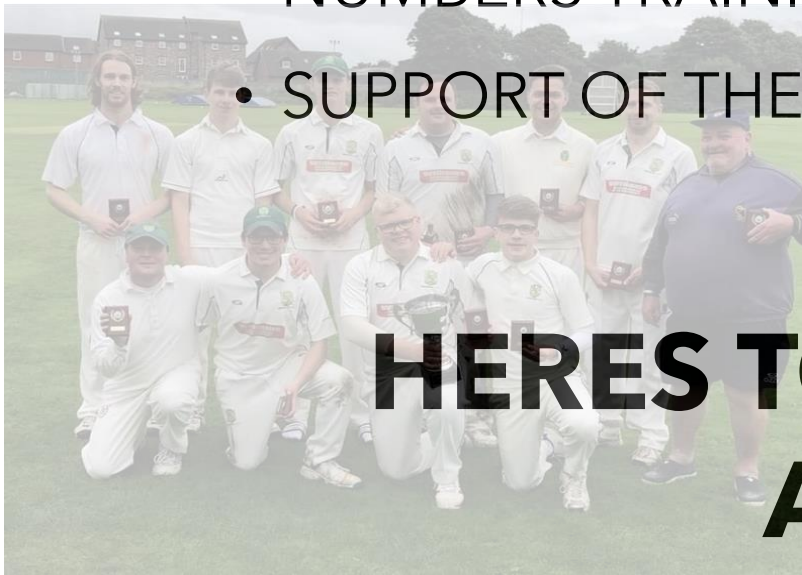
