Notable Changes for 2025

- A Just Giving Page was set up for the Charity
- The School Uniform shop, which was ran by the PTA, often at a loss was disbanded. Any remaining stock was gifted to the school, although it is noted that much is old logo or sizes ordered incorrectly. Moving forward parents are to order directly from the MACPAC website and they will deliver to the school every 2 weeks.
