THE WELFARE OF UNDER PRIVILEGED CHILDREN WHO HAVE BEEN LIVING IN DEPRIVED CIRCUMSTANCES OR WHO HAVE BEEN NEGLECTED OR ILL TREATED, TO INCLUDE THE PROVISION OF SUPPORT TO ANY CHARITABLE CAUSES ASSOCIATED THERETO; AND³. THE PROVISION, MAINTENANCE, IMPROVEMENT AND EQUIPMENT OF HOSPITALS NURSING HOMES HOSPICES AND CLINICS OVER AND ABOVE THAT WHICH WOULD NORMALLY BE PROVIDED BY THE NATIONAL HEALTH SERVICE.
