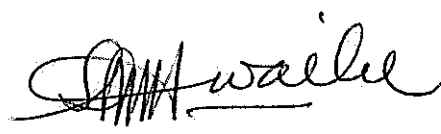

1 Accounting Policies

Basis of Accounting

The Financial Statements are prepared under the provisions of the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective 30 June 2002) on the historical cost basis of accounting and on a going concern basis.

The Company has taken advantage of the exemption afforded to small companies by Financial Reporting Standard 1, and has not prepared a cash flow statement
