CARE Pakistan had an average year ending April 2024. Our objective as a UK based charity is to raise funding in the UK to support the education of under privileged children in Pakistan. We support CARE a Pakistan based charity, which provides education to 250,000 children, boys and girls in 800 schools across Pakistan. It is the largest educational charity in the world and details can be found at www.carepakistan.org.

As a sister but independent charity www.carepakistan.org.uk, we attempt to raise money in the UK towards that cause.

We are completely staffed by volunteers, and our expenditure principally goes towards fund raising events.

In the year ending April 2023, we raised approximately £189k, and we remitted £163k Pakistan. Our fundraising costs for the year were approximately £30k.


