- 2024 has been a year of growth and impact for the church. Through the various church events and initiatives, we have continued to serve our community, fostering connection, support, and development.
- A major opportunity offered by Rugby Town Centre Management, leading to action taken to grow the church and one that would significantly affect our costs, was to be offered a town centre large business premises for free (except utilities). *(We were offered what was previously used by Argos - to give some idea of the size and location)*. This was inspired and led to a massive growth spurt for the church. However, this offer of the facility changed during the 2024 year, as the Church was asked to vacate the original "Argos" premises and move into a different smaller one, where we were asked to pay service charge. This had not been part of the offer in the previous premises. We are therefore still in discussions as to the affordability of this service charge as well as paying the overheads for the new space.
- We continue to support the refugee community in Rugby through our English language classes. We have seen a growth in numbers of those accessing the provision. We have also had quite a few visits to our Church services by some of the students in our English language classes.
- Within the RCCG Global Missions objectives, in 2024 we continued to be a designated viewing centre for various RCCG Europe Continent 9 programmes, so that any RCCG member in our vicinity and in the Warwickshire environs would have a place to join in events and activities.
- Additionally, in November 2024, we, as the Zonal Headquarters for Zone 1, Province 1, Region 4 UK, hosted the second Zonal conference for the Zone, bringing together all pastors, ministers, workers and members of the 28 - 30 RCCG Parishes under the Zone. This year, our Province Pastor, (Who has just been promoted to the post of Regional Pastor of Region 4 UK) was the guest minister. It was a blessing to be the first Parish at which he would minister after his promotion.

The decision to give the founding Pastor, Morola Hayden a regular stipend (agreed 2020 of £500/month) has still not been realised, although a petrol allowance of £50/week has been maintained throughout the year.





- A major opportunity offered by Rugby Town Centre Management, leading to action taken to grow the church and one that would significantly affect our costs, was to be offered a town centre large business premises for free (except utilities). (*We were offered what was previously used by Argos - to give some idea of the size and location*). This was inspired and led to a massive growth spurt for the church. Not without its challenges, the church came together to make a beautiful event location.
The knock-on effect of this was the youth church moving into our leased premises at no 23 Albert Street. No 23 continues as operational office base and is a developing resource, for the homework club and sunday school and youth activities.



Trustees Report 2022

2022 was tagged "Our Year of ever-Increasing Glory". With the support of our new ministers, the church continued growing.

We took on a donation (£25) to the charity Youth for Christ for, Emily Spademan, a Youth worker who approached us for support for a year.

We started a 'Homework Club' to support our children who were preparing to attempt the 11+ examination, as well as helping others with their homework. We started with 3 children and the numbers are still increasing. Good news! One of our children passed very well and was successful in getting a place in his desired grammar school.


On our Minister of religion licence, we employed a children's worker, who started in September 2022.

In October 2022 RCCG Harvest Fellowship became the administrative centre for Africa Missions Region 4 UK... Glory to God.

Pastor Morola Hayden, the founding pastor of the church for, has served in this position for the last 19 years. Pastor Ola is not paid a salary or regular stipend up till date (although the trustees have mandated, she should be put on a salary. This in 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021) the church has not been buoyant enough to do so. In 2020 it was then decided that a small stipend of £500 monthly should be given her as well as a full tank of petrol per week. Unfortunately, the monthly stipend has still not been possible and Pastor Morola herself decided £50 petrol would be adequate. She would take the £500 per month as and when available. To date she has not taken it.

As a matter of what is right and for the blessings of the parish, the trustees have insisted that her attendance at Solemn Assembly yearly must be supported with £1000 each year. We are happy to report that this was possible in February 2022.

Due to the 'cost of living crisis' in late 2022 we offered up our space as a winter warm hub as part of the national initiative. We were successful with a funding application to Sports England for £1900+, for activities throughout the winter. Its success means we are carrying on this same initiative for the winter of 2023 and beyond to assist those in our community suffering from effects of the cost-of-living crisis.



A quiet year coming out of Covid-19 restrictions where church membership grew slowly (online and in person). Significantly and in collaboration with our church plant; World Changers Young People's Church, we held regular and joint monthly 'Night Vigils', new year 'Crossover' services and the regular 21 day 'Daniel Fast' in August. Normal Sunday service and Wednesday Bible study was given-out in *hybrid* both 'In-person' and online.

The church continued to pay Central Office and W.E.M. dues, indeed were commended by RCCG Central Office as one parish to have faithfully kept up contributions through the years. We participated in all RCCG Missions UK National programmes and events. Pastor Morola Hayden was promoted to post of Zonal Pastor.

In June the church refreshed interest in and re-activated the CAP Jobclub and started by taking training online. This continued throughout 2021 with the intention to start in 2022.


It is with great regret that this year I announce the death of the church accountant who, through his long service has helped us, the church in innumerable ways. Through recommendation we engaged Mr Olutomi Osibanjo (AMCT) of Bristol.

The Church had to release the young Pastor Augustin Zacchaeus from employment and withdraw him from our tier2 sponsorship (Oct 2021), as he had not been straightforward with us and hid his real intentions; nor was he willing to serve the vision of the church.

On 01/09/21 we engaged Pastor Dupe Alao-Peters 'Pastor in charge of Administration, Church Planting and Family Life Matters' on the tier2 sponsorship route. Her whole family was welcomed in a special service on 19/09. Roy Crowne - President of Hope together and CEO Revelation Trust, preached the sermon, and Pastor Yemi Ladipo chair of the board of Trustees was in attendance, representing the Trustees.

Later in the year, 'Rugby Community Gospel Choir' was set up. It is a cross-community outreach including people of all faiths. This was a direct result of and to combat the isolation effects of the Covid pandemic. They held a successful Christmas concert showing a desire of more to come.

The trustees have held one main meeting(05/08) and several remote (zoom) meetings, mainly to discuss and decide upon matters concerning the actions of the young pastor Augustin. Next trustees meeting should be in new year 2022.

The Trustees present their annual report together with the receipts and payments account of the Redeemed Christian Church of God (RCCG) Harvest Fellowship (Rugby) [**the Trust**] for the period ended 31st December 2020.

The Trustees elected to prepare **the Trust's** financial statements on a receipt and payment basis under section 133 of the Charities Act 2011. The Trustees also elected for an independent examination of the Charity's accounts under section 475 of the Companies Act 2006. The **Trust** is constituted under a declaration of trust dated 13 August 2004 and registered by the Charity Commissioners on 6 May 2005. It is a registered charity, No.1109356. Stephen Eric Hayden is the sole remaining original Trustee and is entitled to hold office for life. Future Trustees are appointed by resolution of the existing Trustees.

The objects of the charity are the advancement of the Christian faith world-wide and the relief of poverty.

There were no related party events occurring during the period under review

After an hiatus period of three years with the church office in the home of trustee Stephen Hayden, we entered into 2020 with a clean slate and plans to become more established in Rugby.

We had been renting office space in the Christian bookshop (Greater Things) and renting a larger meeting space, in the Baptist church for £25 on a Sunday afternoon.

The Covid-19 pandemic took effect from late March and everything closed. Later in the year, the lockdown lifted and anticipating change, we negotiated a 5 year lease on 23 Albert Street, Rugby CV21 2SD which is now our office and meeting room base. Here we continue to recoup and recover after lockdown. Indeed we continued throughout holding regular services, (Sunday family worship and Wednesday bible study) online where necessary and later as lockdown lifted, in person.

Sanmi Akanmu joined us on our Minister of Religion (MoR)- Sponsorship licence as minister in charge of Music Ministry. We successfully renewed our Tier2 – MoR Sponsorship Licence after 4 years. We recruited Assistant Pastor Augustin Zaccaeus, on our new Sponsorship licence as Assistant Pastor CSR, Community Engagement, Missions and Projects, later in the year.

We joined in with the 'Love Christmas' initiative giving out 20 small hampers to homeless people in Rugby. We continued to pay our Central Office Fund commitments.

We had 2 Trustees meetings, 10th February and 7th May.

We thank our donors, whose continuous giving has enabled us to fund the operation of the charity, especially in terms of remuneration.

The cash reserves at year end was £1,472.16

As the charity trustees of the Trust, you are responsible for the preparation of the accounts in accordance with the requirements of the Charities Act 2011 ('the Act').


