We encourage and enable them to be part of the community and give positive contribution.

Awaaz offers free services to all women regardless of age or ethnicity. We keep a track of our ladies through WhatsApp groups.

Our aim is to empower them and enable them to be confident and lead an integrated life where they can have a positive attitude towards life. We work with women who suffer from illnesses, disabilities, isolation, and depression and have been exposed to domestic abuse and domestic violence. We encourage and enable them to be part of the community and give positive contribution.

Awaaz offers free services to all women regardless of age or ethnicity. We give them digital training and have delivered workshops on different topics such as knife and gun crime, healthy eating, online safety etc. Since Covid-19 we are still meeting up and delivering our services online through zoom sessions. We provide one to one counselling sessions. During the pandemic we have been distributing food vouchers and some household item and toiletries to the needy. We have been lending tablets to our service users so that they can keep in touch and attend regularly. We keep a track of our ladies through WhatsApp groups.
