Para 1.20	<p><b><i>Sustainable income Generation -</i></b> 7 families were give small business grants to set-up own business and 4 families were provided with training to generate and maintain regular income.</p> <p><b><i>Hardship Support</i></b> Many families needed support with basics such as food. 4,920 individuals benefitted from hardship grants.</p> <p><b><i>Ramadan Food Parcels for 349 families.</i></b> Most of the people we work with live hand to mouth and if they don't work for a day they have no rood. In Ramadan, it is often difficult to find work. We provided basic food parcel at a cost of £30 per parcel containing items such as rice, lentils, salt, sugar, onion and oil. Our priority was widows and orphans, enabling them to have food security for the month of Ramadan.</p> <p><b><i>Medical Treatment &amp; Medicine -</i></b> We supported 49 individual and families with medical costs.</p> <p><b><i>House building -</i></b> There was a large number of requests for housing costs support due to adverse weather causing flooding. 43 individuals and their families were supported.</p>

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

