Grants received and donations made are slightly more than in the prior year, but the trustees are confident that this is due to year on year variations, rather than a long term trend.</p> <p>These grants are made to families suffering from sickness or poverty, and these grants have enabled these families or individuals to alleviate some of their distress.</p>


