The personal visits have been replaced by regular Zoom meetings, WhatsApp messaging and extensive telephone calls.</p> <p>Funding continues within FCRA permits.</p> <p>Isolation of the people we help has continued into this year with restrictions gradually lifting. The lockdowns have been strictly enforced. However, our long-standing work in the area has enabled home contacts to be maintained.</p> <p>As the restrictions are lifting we are beginning to operate our tuition centre.</p> <p>Our staff have been provided with personal protective materials, however, all did contract the virus.</p> <p>It is anticipated that visits to India will be permitted from April / May 2022.</p>
