Mawdesley Equine & People Trust [Charity no 1113726] in its thirteenth year of operation since it was formed as an amalgamation of the functions of Backhouse Horse Welfare, Assessment & Therapy Centre and Backhouse Therapeutic Equestrian Centre, has continued to carry on its activities at Backhouse Stables in Mawdesley, now formally described as Jigsaw Stables.
