Three of the Trustees visited India in September, at their own expense. It being four years since the last visit due to travel restrictions during Covid . All of the charity's sites were inspected and meetings held with members of the management team . The Trustees were able to satisfy themselves that all projects funded by PFI had been delivered in accordance with instructions and that appropriate standards had been maintained or improved. The Trustees formally "opened" the newly constructed building which replaced the old Rescue Junction site .The solar electric installation, funded by a donation from the Oxted group was switched on. The group were very grateful for the excellent organisation of their visit.
