JAUk was able to collect the amount of of GBP 44,200.00 to contribute to the tuition fees fund and help with the campus maintenance of essential parts. JAUk was able to make a grant of GBP 115,000 (amount collected over the past 4 years) to contribute to a campus refurbishment project valued at USD 250,000.</b>


