The charity works closely with Addenbrookes Hospital where it co-founded the Brainbow rehabilitation service for children with brain tumours. After 10 years of funding by Anna's Hope the service is now fully funded by the hospital.

Anna's Hope continue to support and develop Brainbow with the funding of a Clinical Lead with the aim of developing the service to help more children.

Anna's Hope is a member of Brain Tumour Research.

The charity has a low risk approach so that the charity is not exposed to any major or medium risks.

In addition to fundraising, Anna's Hope continues to raise awareness locally, regionally, and nationally and collaborates with other charities and is a proud member of Brain Tumour Research.



