#### **Constitution and Objects**

Krushna Krupa Trust is a private limited is a registered charity number 1116985.

The object of the charity is to further the education and training of children, assist in relief of poverty, provide provide overseas aid/ famine relief and assist in promoting Hindu Religion.

#### **Organisation**

The trustees who have served during the year and since the year end are set out on page 2. Trustees are appointed by the board of trustees and serve for 5 years after which period they may put themselves forward to re-appointment.

#### **Trustees' Responsibilities in Relation to the Financial Statements**
