### **Trustee's Report 2024.**

There were no changes to trustees during 2023. However in 2025 Mr Rowe has stood down as a trustee, leaving us temporarily with only two trustees. A replacement trustee has been found and will be appointed in the near future. Robert Rowe's resignation was due to an accusation of abuse made by an ex-resident in Romania against him and a number of others not connected to Love Light Romania. All protest their innocence. The matter is being investigated by the Police and the Social authorities.

The trustees continue to believe that due to the sums involved and the limited number of transactions made, neither an independent examination of the accounts nor an audit is required.

All records are available for inspection by interested parties.

### **Activities.**

In 2024, at the Sanctuary, the home of young people suffering from HIV, the three young adults who are funded by Share, a separate UK charity, continue to live alongside fully integrated with the Love Light residents.

In Jacodu there has been continued progress made on all projects. The Education Centre continues to play an important part in the community, the agricultural project proceeds but without the involvement of the Roma community. It provides a substantial amount of the food for the Sanctuary.

The majority of fund-raising activities continue to be instigated by Love Light Romania utilising the Internet.

The winter clothes parcels that are primarily for the Roma community continue to be well-received.

### **Other matters.**

Love Light Romania Aid now, and for the foreseeable future is operated solely and exclusively to support Love Light Romania in their work to alleviate poverty and the effects of sickness in Romania. As such all trustees give their time freely. There are no employees. In 2023, at the Sanctuary, the home of young people suffering from HIV, the young adults who are funded by Share, a separate charity, have now fully integrated with Love Light residents. There has been one new arrival, an adult HIV sufferer who was homeless in the Sibiu region was referred to Love Light Romania by the authorities and Love Light was pleased to be able to assist. Because of his background and experience in care work he has become a real asset to the team.

In Jacodu there has been continued progress made on all projects. The Education Centre continues to play an important part in the community, the agricultural project proceeds but without the involvement of the Roma community. It provides a substantial amount of the food for the Sanctuary.

The majority of fund-raising activities continue to be instigated by Love Light Romania utilising the Internet.

The winter clothes parcels that are primarily for the Roma community continue to be well-received.

### **Other matters.**

There were no changes to trustees during 2022. The need to strengthen our Board of Trustees was recognised in 2018, but due to the pandemic and subsequent 'catching up' this has not been possible to date.

The trustees continue to believe that due to the sums involved and the limited number of transactions made, neither an independent examination of the accounts nor an audit is required.

All records are available for inspection by interested parties.

### **Activities.**

In 2022 the outbreak of war in Ukraine caused a huge number of refugees to arrive in Romania, Love Light Romania, with agreement from Love Light Romania Aid felt bound to assist in the alleviation of the distress they witnessed. An appeal was made for funds to assist in the housing of the refugees, the provision of aid to the Ukraine border and the transport of the refugees to towns and villages close to Sibiu. The actions helped to significantly reduce the hardship suffered by many of the displaced persons.

At the Sanctuary, the home of young people suffering from HIV, things have now returned to the pre-pandemic state. A significant amount of refurbishment has been carried out and the residents are assisting in many of the tasks of maintaining a happy home.

In Jacodu there has been continued progress made on all projects. The Education Centre continued to play an important role in the community. The agricultural project proceeds but without the involvement of the Roma community that it was primarily intended to benefit. The work of distributing food-parcels to the poverty stricken families in the Roma community of Albesti also continued, but the funds for this were sent directly to Love Light in Romania and thus did not impact on Love Light Romania Aid this year.

The majority of fund-raising activities continue to be instigated by Love Light Romania utilising the Internet..

### **Other matters.**

Love Light Romania Aid now, and for the foreseeable future is operated solely and exclusively to support Love Light Romania in their work to alleviate poverty and the effects of sickness in Romania. As such all trustees give their time freely. There are no employees. ### **Trustee's Report 2021.**

There were no changes to trustees during 2021. The need to strengthen our Board of Trustees was recognised in 2018, but due to the pandemic this has not been possible to date.

The trustees continue to believe that due to the sums involved and the limited number of transactions made, neither an independent examination of the accounts nor an audit is required.

All records are available for inspection by interested parties.

### **Activities.**

During the year of 2021 the Covid-19 Pandemic has prevented UK-based trustees from visiting Romania. However as one trustee lives permanently in Romania, all trustees are continually updated

At the Sanctuary, the home of young people suffering from HIV, the pandemic caused some disruption primarily due to staff testing positive on a few occasions. This caused periods of self-isolation and the necessary changes to staff working arrangements to cover the resulting absences. In general however, the organisation proved resilient and capable of coping with such difficulties. The young residents of the Sanctuary also proved to be able to adapt to the changing circumstances in which they found themselves. Although some extra curtailment of freedom was necessary they have continued ongoing activities and have been heavily involved in the growing of vegetables in the poly-tunnels.

In Jacodu there has been continued progress made on all projects. The Education Centre had to be closed for the periods of 'Lock-down' but this served to high-light the important role it now fills in the community. Similarly, the agricultural project had to proceed but without the involvement of the Roma community that it was primarily intended to benefit. The work of distributing food-parcels to the poverty stricken families in the Roma community of Albesti also continued, but the funds for this were sent directly to Love Light in Romania and thus did not impact on Love Light Romania Aid this year.

The majority of fund-raising activities continue to be instigated by Love Light Romania utilising the Internet. The revamped web-site is now up and running. It has been entirely created within Romania, Love Light Romania Aid have not provided funding or advice on this project.

### **Other matters.**

Love Light Romania Aid now, and for the foreseeable future is operated solely and exclusively to support Love Light Romania in their work to alleviate poverty and the effects of sickness in Romania. *As such all trustees give their time freely. There are no employees. We are committed to the principal that all monies donated go directly to the benefit of the children and young persons we seek to aid.*

### **Trustee's Report 2020.**

There were no changes to trustees during 2020. The need to strengthen our Board of Trustees was recognised in 2018, but this has not been possible to date.

The trustees continue to believe that due to the sums involved and the limited number of transactions made, neither an independent examination of the accounts nor an audit is required.

All records are available for inspection by interested parties.

#### **Activities.**

During the year of 2020 the Covid-19 Pandemic has prevented UK-based trustees from visiting Romania. However as one trustee lives permanently in Romania, all trustees are continually updated.

At the Sanctuary, the home of young people suffering from HIV, the pandemic caused some disruption primarily due to staff testing positive on a few occasions. This caused periods of self-isolation and the necessary changes to staff working arrangements to cover the resulting absences. In general however, the organisation proved resilient and capable of coping with such difficulties. The young residents of the Sanctuary also proved to be able to adapt to the changing circumstances in which they found themselves. Although some extra curtailment of freedom was necessary they have continued ongoing activities and have been heavily involved in the growing of vegetables in the poly-tunnels.

In Jacodu there has been continued progress made on all projects. The Education Centre had to be closed for the periods of 'Lock-down' but this served to high-light the important role it now fills in the community. Similarly, the agricultural project had to proceed but without the involvement of the Roma community that it was primarily intended to benefit. The work of distributing food-parcels to the poverty stricken families in the Roma community of Albesti also continued, but the funds for this were sent directly to Love Light in Romania and thus did not impact on Love Light Romania Aid this year.

The majority of fund-raising activities continue to be instigated by Love Light Romania utilising the Internet. Work on revamping and updating the Love Light Romania web-site commenced (in Romania) just before the pandemic struck. It could not be continued until after the lock-down restrictions had been lifted, but (at time of writing) has now been completed.

#### **Other matters.**

Love Light Romania Aid now, and for the foreseeable future is operated solely and exclusively to support Love Light Romania in their work to alleviate poverty and the effects of sickness in Romania. As such all trustees give their time freely. There are no employees. We are committed to the principal that all monies donated go directly to the benefit of the children and young persons we seek to aid.
