





The charity continues to refer users and provide backup and support in this regard. A large focus remains assisting children and teenagers with special educational /emotional needs to provide advocacy, guidance and therapeutic interventions. Feedback has been extremely positive. Outside support for the charity has been good. In addition the charity owns a property which is generating a steady income stream.
