### **Charitable Objectives of British Society of Gerodontology (BSG)**

The aim of the society is to protect, maintain and improve the oral health of older people. This is achieved by providing a forum to further knowledge and increase awareness relating to the oral health, dental needs and treatment of older adults.

The society holds two conferences per year when members of various dental specialities and dental care professionals, and others with an interest, come together to consider and exchange information on the oral health care of older adults.

## **BSG Annual Scientific Meetings Financial Year 24/25**

### **Summer Meeting 14<sup>th</sup> June 2024 and Winter Meeting 5<sup>th</sup> December 2024**

The BSG Spring Scientific Meeting took place in Cardiff on the 14<sup>th</sup> June as a face-to-face meeting with 98 delegates. Presentations were delivered by the wider team on topics related to endodontics, digitalisation, social exclusion, mouth care in the inpatient setting, and sedation for older adults. A summary of the conference was published in the British Dental Journal. <https://www.nature.com/articles/s41415-025-8991-x>. Feedback included integration of clinical cases into the conference.

The BSG Winter Scientific Meeting took place in London on 5<sup>th</sup> December, 140 delegates attended. The title was 'Clinical Cases and Innovations in Gerodontology'. Speaker topics included addressing the use of amalgam in older adults, Legislative Changes for Dental Therapists and Dental Hygienists, Perioperative Medicine for Older People Undergoing Surgery, promoting empathy towards the older population and some clinical cases and a panel discussion using the program 'Slido'.

The feedback from both conferences proved them to be successful. The outcome of the conference highlighted that delegates wish to receive practical advice for 'wet fingered dentists' that may change their practice in the future.

### **BSG Annual General Meeting (AGM) 5th December 2024**

BSG members attended the face to face AGM after the Winter Scientific Meeting on 5<sup>th</sup> December 2024. Reports were received from the president, treasurer, secretary, membership secretary, website editor, social media secretary and sponsorship secretary. Ordinary general meetings (OGM) were held face to face 13<sup>th</sup> June 2024 and virtually on and 16<sup>th</sup> of September 2024.

### **BSG Sponsorship**

Overall, Sponsorship is getting narrower due to the current financial climate. The design-specific team had to pull out of the June 2024 conference due to staff shortages. Two sponsors, GC and Oralieve attended the June conference. The sponsorship secretary contacted existing sponsors early for the Winter Meeting 2024. All sponsors were charged £350.

## **Charity Activities**

The charity pledged £5000 towards a standalone BSG research grant. Three excellent research applications were received. An StR Special Care Dentistry awarded research application that aims to 'Map of gerontology in undergraduate curriculum topics'. Early career research prize to be offered again at the winter conference in 2025 conference. The committee have agreed there is potential to share this money across two research projects.

BSG provided applications for free dental care professional (DCP) places to attend the Summer and Winter meetings in 2024. 10 places were available for each of the conferences.

As per previous outcomes from 2023 conferences, BSG have been involved in a Silver diamine fluoride (SDF) project. A working group to produce some resources on the use of SDF with adults was put together, and a future presentation within one of the conferences is expected.

The committee have agreed on the need for updated domiciliary dental care guidelines as the previous guidelines were from 2008 by the British Society of Special Care Dentistry. BSG have agreed to update these jointly with the British Society of Special Care Dentistry and will ensure all four nations and DCPs are included. The aim is to have these published in 2026.

Committee members are also leading on additional guidance in collaboration with:

1. Oral health and ageing. Royal College of Surgeons of England
  2. Oral health and the older person clinical guideline, Office of the Chief Dental Officer
- Both guidance are due for publication in 2026

## **BSG poster competition and prizes**

A poster competition was organised, with winners announced during the Winter Scientific meeting hosted by BSG on 5th December 2024. 26 applications for posters were received. Prizes were offered for the best poster presentations on a subject relevant to older people and oral health, submitted in one of the following categories: case study, audit or quality improvement, innovation or research. There was a prize of £250 for the winner of each category for the following groups: dental care professionals, dental core trainees, specialist trainees, and dentists.

## **BSG Committee Links with Other Groups**

BSG committee members continue to have links with other societies, charities and agencies including British Geriatric Society, British Society Special Care Dentistry, British Dental Association and Faculty of Dental Surgery. BSG provided input and response to guidance on Oral

health for Older People Living with Frailty, Delivering Better Oral Health and CQC 'Smiling Matters' report. BSG members have provided presentations and submission of articles to peer reviewed journals and other relevant organisations. BSG provide representation at senate and Specialist Advisory Committee for Special Care Dentistry.

BSG delivered a webinar series titled 'Gerodontology - Caring for an Increasingly Complex Older Population', the titles and topics included:

1. Polypharmacy and Medical Complexity in Gerodontology, 12th June 2024
2. Prevention of Oral Diseases and Commissioning of Care through Ageing, 17th July 2024
3. The Dark Arts of Complete and Partial Dentures, 5th September 2024

The BSG committee also submitted a series of articles for a Dental Update Edition focused on the oral health of older people, which will be published in 2026.

BSG is working in partnership with the British Geriatrics Society on a webinar on Oral Health for older people and developing microlearning.

BSG has been represented at **round table discussions led by the Office of the Chief Dental Officer (OCDO)**.

Committee members have represented the Society through invited lectures at national conferences, including the **British Society of Prosthodontics (March 2025)** and the **British Society of Geriatrics** annual meeting.

The Society has strengthened its communications strategy with an **active LinkedIn profile and Instagram presence**. In line with member engagement trends, the Society has formally withdrawn from Twitter/X.

## **BSG Annual Scientific Meetings Financial Year 23/24**

### **Spring Meeting 28<sup>th</sup> April 2023 and Winter Meeting 30<sup>th</sup> November 2023**

The BSG Spring Scientific Meeting took place in Belfast on 28<sup>th</sup> April as a face to face meeting 'Integrated Dental Care for Older People'. Presentations were delivered by the wider team related to older peoples nutrition, behaviour change and caries. The feedback was excellent. This was a face to face event in hosting over 80 delegates.

The BSG Winter Scientific Meeting took place in London on 30<sup>th</sup> November 2023. 125 delegates attended. Speaker topics included, addressing oral health inequalities for older adults, the role of the dental team in delivering oral health for older adults, co-designing digital services for community dental service and vulnerable patient groups, oral care for patients with dysphagia post-stroke and functionally orientated tooth replacement

The outcome of both conferences was the need to address the development of guidelines for the use of Sodium Diamine Fluoride (SDF) in older adults and to develop an online webinar series with the Royal College of Surgeons (RCS) Edinburgh.

### **BSG Annual General Meeting (AGM) 30<sup>th</sup> November 2023**

BSG members attended the face to face AGM after the Winter Scientific Meeting on 30<sup>th</sup> November 2023. Reports were received from the president, treasurer, secretary, membership secretary, website editor, social media secretary and sponsorship secretary. Ordinary general meetings (OGM) were held face to face 27<sup>th</sup> April 2023 and virtually on and 10<sup>th</sup> of October 2023.

### **BSG Sponsorship**

GC was the only sponsor for the spring meeting 28th April 2023 with an increased price of £350. Other sponsors were not able to attend due to location of the conference being in Northern Ireland and clashes with other events. The sponsorship secretary contacted existing sponsors early for the Winter Meeting 2023. Two sponsors attended the winter 2023 meeting, design specific and Oralive, both charged £350. Discussed uncertainty with sponsorship future, a key contact from GC had retired. Companies are re-visiting if going to do sponsorship as budgets are reducing so may not be replying to requests. Curaden was identified as a sponsor that was keen to work with us for the following year.

### **BSG Charity Activities**

The charity pledged £5000 towards a standalone BSG research grant. This was previously affiliated with the Faculty of Dental Surgery (FDS). It was agreed to keep this as standalone to maximise participation and inclusion as the previous requirement was to be an RCS England member.

BSG provided application for free dental care professional (DCP) places to attend the Summer (10 free places) and Winter meetings (5 free places) in 2023.

A resource list on Oral Health Guidelines relevant to older people is available on the BSG website. The website was updated with a GDPR policy.

**Charitable Objectives**

The aim of the society is to protect, maintain and improve the oral health of older people. This is achieved by providing a forum to further knowledge and increase awareness relating to the oral health, dental needs and treatment of older adults. The society holds two meetings per year when members of various dental specialities and dental care professionals and others with an interest come together to consider and exchange information on the oral health care of older adults.

**BSG Annual Scientific Meetings Financial Year 22/23**

**Summer Meeting - 10<sup>th</sup> June 2022**

The BSG Summer Scientific Meeting took place Sheffield on 10<sup>th</sup> June 2022 as a face to face meeting 'Integrated Dental Care for Older People'. Presentations were delivered by the wider team supporting older people including advance care planning, treating older adults with dignity in a community setting rather than in hospital and shared decision making from consultant community physician and haematology for the older person from consultant in haematology. An update on area of good practice was provided on Residential Oral Care Sheffield initiative relating to oral health and comprehensive oral care for care home residents involving both the community and general dental services. Speakers also provided dental clinical updates and treatment planning for older people in endodontics, implants, removable prosthodontics and oral medicine. This was the first face to face meeting post covid and was successful in hosting over 50 delegates.

**Winter Meeting - 1<sup>st</sup> December 2022**

The BSG Winter Scientific Meeting took place in London on 1<sup>st</sup> December 2022 as a face to face meeting with 105 delegates attending. The theme of the meeting was 'Innovations in Gerodontology - translating research into practice'. Speakers provided presentations on potential educational and workforce strategies to meet the oral health challenges of an increasingly older population in the UK, updates from the office of the Chief Dental Officer England on innovative work for vulnerable

older people and future plans for 'Smiling Matters' initiative for oral health in care homes. There were also presentations that could be readily applied to the dental clinical environment including minimally invasive dentistry, understanding the experience of wearing dentures and key findings and implications in the 'dental decisions study' for treatment decision making with or for people living with dementia. The successful pump-priming grant applicant in 2021 for the joint BSG / Faculty of Dental Surgery (Royal College of Surgeons of England) research grant provided an update on their project '3D Scanning and Printing dentures in care homes, a BSG funded feasibility study'.

### **BSG Annual General Meeting (AGM), 1<sup>st</sup> December 2022**

BSG members attended the face to face AGM after the Winter Scientific Meeting on 1<sup>st</sup> December 2022. Reports were received from the chair, president, treasurer, secretary, membership secretary, website editor, social media secretary and sponsorship secretary.

Request for Special Care Dentistry Specialty Trainee representation was accepted and agreed. New committee members were elected. Gerry McKenna was elected to be president in 2023 and Adele Cunningham as president elect for 2024.

OGM meetings were held face to face 9<sup>th</sup> June 2022 and and virtually on and 21<sup>st</sup> October 2022.

### **BSG charity objectives:**

The charity pledged £5000 towards a £10,000 pump-priming grant with the Faculty of Dental Surgery (Royal College of Surgeons of England), for research supporting the society's aims and towards a project/research aimed at older people. There was a successful application in 2022 for funding towards research into tele dentistry in care homes to improve access to oral health services for vulnerable older people.

BSG provided application for free dental care professional (DCP) places to attend the Summer (10 free places) and Winter meetings (6 free places) in 2022.

### **Oral health resources for older people**

A resource list on Oral Health Guidelines relevant to older people is available on the BSG website.

### **BSG poster competition and prizes**

A poster competition was organised with winners announced during the Winter Scientific meeting hosted by BSG on 1<sup>st</sup> December 2022. Prizes were offered for the best poster presentations on a subject relevant to older people and oral health, submitted in one of the following categories: case study, audit or quality improvement, innovation or research. There was a prize of £250 for the winner of each category for the following groups; dental care professional, dental core trainee, specialist trainee and dentist. The posters were available to view all day during the meeting and were made available for viewing on the BSG website ([www.gerodontology.com](http://www.gerodontology.com)). There were 12 entrants to the competition.

### **BSG committee activity/Links with other groups and Initiatives**

Continued links with other societies, charities and agencies (British Geriatric Society, British Society Special Care Dentistry, British Dental Association, Irish Society for Disability and Oral Health) and response to national consultations - Faculty of Dental Surgery, Royal College of Surgeons (RCS) Oral health for older people living with frailty, Delivering Better Oral Health and CQC 'Smiling Matters' report.

A BSG committee member published a book as co-author 'Oral Health and Dental Care in the Ageing Population'. BSG members have provided presentations and submission of articles to peer reviewed journals and other relevant organisations. BSG are members on RCS, RCS, Senate, FDS (England). Members of the charity have been involved in the national Mouth Care Matters project in England and Gwen am Byth in Wales.
