## **Trustees Annual Report (TAR) of Amazing Grace Church London - Year End 2022**

The aftermath of this and the restrictions have also effected this year negatively. However the YE 2023 will show increase and good improvements. For the accounting year 2023 the IT infrastructure will be renewed and expanded. We carried on our goal of outreach and helping and faith-based prayer to those with in need of help. Due to previous expansion of the outreach to the USA and Australia it was able to help both in UK, Europe, USA and Australia. Looking at the accounting year 2023 outreach will include India and Africa.

Of course there is much more to be done, but to do more and grow, as stated inn the last TAR which was delayed because of covid-19 implications at least one more person of staff is required, this has been discussed with the Trustees and is the aim for the next year, to bring more structured growth. More fundraising is definitely needed and with the help of this person part-time even that can prayerfully be achieved.
