Our aims and objectives are to make donations to children and young people who are sick, disabled or have special needs in order to improve their conditions of life and to advance the education of pupils attending schools in Romford, Essex and its surrounding area by providing and assisting in the provision of facilities not required to be provided by the local education authority for education at the schools. We raise the funds required to achieve our aims by carrying out various fundraising activities including a Summer Ball.

In addition, the trustees consider that Wipe Away Those Tears gives added public benefit by its rapid and flexible responses to the applications that it receives.


