Independent examiner's report to the trustees of The Rescue Trust of North West Golden Retriever Club

I report on the accounts of The Rescue Trust of North West Golden Retriever Club for the year ended 31st December 2025 which are set out on page 3.

Respective responsibilities of the Trustees and Examiner
