

During the course of accounted period ended 5th May 2022 the Trust (TSE & WT) in UK assisted and supported in financing "Ehsas Charitable Trust, Sansrod, India" the total sum of Indian Rupees 2677000.00 equivalent to UK £23460.17 approximately in order them to help all needy intellectual students in their educational and help others in their medical and welfare needs in Sansrod, India as below.

1a) Education Awareness

The Trust held a seminar in conjunction with Ehsas Charitable Trust, Sansrod, India at Sansrod to make aware of importance of the education for benefit of pupils at Sansrod, India.

2) Medical Facility

- a) The Trust helped to run Medical Centre in Sansrod, India for needy and sick people where primary treatment was given in local medical centre. Last year poor people are also treated in nearby hospitals for all kind of diseases, minor and major medical operations. Last year running cost to run medical operations to the with Ehsas Charitable Trust, Sansrod, India Sansrod Welfare Trust, Sansrod, India , was approximately Indian Rupees 612,988 (Equivalent to UK Pounds £5,900) approximately. The Ehsas Charitable Trust, Sansrod, India, also held medical camps to help sick people in their long term illness.

The Sansrod Educational & Welfare Trust

- b) The Trust in U.K.in conjunction with Ehsas Trust, Sansrod, India, helped to poor people to carry out the major and minor operations and also provides medicine to long term disease. .
- c) Due to current Pandemic the trust helped local community Indian Rupees 5,000,000 equivalent to U.K. sterling £4900 approximately.

3) Welfare Activities

- a) The Trust in U.K. in conjunction with Ehsas Charitable Trust, Sansrod, India, did provide basic food necessity for a month in Sansrod, India to nearly 100-poor families at the expense of Indian Rupees 150,000 equivalent of U.K. £1,500 approximately.
- b) The Trust in India. Also helped girls in learning in sewing so that they can become independent.


