### **1: Church membership**

- (a) Membership in the UK is spiritually active; news from Pakistan is very encouraging in terms of numerical growth as well as spiritual development.

### **In-House Service Atmosphere**

There is great Christian brotherly unity peace and true liberty between members of all ages and genders. There have not been any personal grievances between members since 2014. Members testify that they cannot wait for church services because of the experience of tangible love from every member of the church.

The Holy Spirit's presence has been consistently powerful in the ministry as a result, with outcomes of physical miracles and healings.

#### **(b) Other Ministry events**

We had thirty (30) church group witnessing / evangelistic outreaches to the lost, for Christ this year; in addition to individual member's outreaches.

All monthly Holy Communion services were held. We had a 3-day Easter prayer meeting for members, community, and nations; in addition to our yearly spiritually- fulfilling November Thanksgiving service, Christmas Carol nights, and New Year's Eve service; as well as monthly prayer vigil.

We thank God that we did not lose any of our members to death, for the years April 2022 to March 2023. We pray and trust our loving Christ and God to sustain us all continually with good health and long life until the glorious appointed time of our peaceful departure to meet with Him in paradise, in Jesus' Name Amen

### **(2) Church Finance: and Bank services**

Also, the LORD has blessed the majority of members with employment, resulting in more voluntary contributions in obedience to the biblical doctrine of tithes and offerings to carry on with the work of His Kingdom on earth. As such we have been able to meet our concurrent financial obligations, without borrowing or engaging in public fund-raising outside the ministry, nor grant from the government. This, we intend to continue believing that God will supply to do His work as the scriptures confirm, Phil. 4: 19; 1 Thess. 5: 24; Luke 1: 37.

Our online banking is yet to be set up because of the residential distance separating the appointed signatories. We intend to consult the bank to sort it out; to adjust signature requirements to enhance the online banking system

### **Church Welfare to community and members**

We experienced an increase in welfare spending for church members: bereavements, elderly / widow care, gifts for children during Christian festivities, local community love feasts, transport fares /help for the unemployed, appreciation blessings for new entrants to UNI, etc.

The figures can be seen in the church's annual accounts and returns. We operate in practical love; which equally extends to members of the community – the needy when we identify them anywhere

**(3) New place of worship**

For some obvious reasons, the trustees and members are aware of our moving out from 63 St. Mary's Road on 10<sup>th</sup> March 2023, to Church Hall, St. Pauls' Herne Hill, SE24, 9LY. Hence our worship times changed to, 1 pm to 4 pm on Sundays and we have reflected this on our website.

And the Good Lord is still blessing us; as at the time of this report no member of the church was unemployed and students passed their exams at various stages of their studies with flying colours, glory to Jesus alone Amen

We are still experiencing a galore of miracles from the Lord; and visitors to the ministry who had health issues were all healed, of all kinds of health issues and after they go back to their places of worship and we are happy with that because our Lord is gracious; as the testimonies page of our website can testify. Some unbelievers too were not left out, and those who were not ready to change and settle for their salvation also receive healings joyfully from the Lord and go home. They reflect all nations and colours. We are very grateful unto Jesus Christ our Lord and Saviour.

On 9<sup>th</sup> June 2021 someone outside the ministry gave us a gift for a car. But due to the introduction of ULEZ, we could not use the car for too long depriving the Pastor, of the use of it unfortunately. Accordingly, the servant of God resorted to using public transport till a future time

**Church Finance:**

The ministry income source remains the same – members' voluntary tithes and offerings and occasional donations from members and visitors in appreciation of God's blessings through the church.

All details for income and expenses were duly recorded in the church accounts spreadsheet; and after this meeting, the year 2021 / 2022 Annual accounts and Returns including the independent examiner's report and the trustees' report were now being put together for submission.

**Bank account development:**

On 23<sup>rd</sup> August 2021 evangelist Chris Ekechi visited the Barclays Peckham branch for an online church account to be put in place. We needed a change for the online signatories as the previous set-up was now difficult to operate. due to changes in the banking system. After security checks, the customer service personnel via phone said two trustees need to write for approval of change and new signatories; as at the time of this report, that is yet to be done and we had never ever used online banking to make transfers other than direct payments for purchases using a bank card. So, we put down the name of two of our trustees to write the letter, based on proximity.

**TV Ministry:**

The TV broadcast was suspended till a future date, to provide for other areas of ministry such as the intended crusade planned for overseas

**Overseas Mission:**

Feedback and video clips sent from Pakistani branches of the ministry indicate that they are thriving and expanding numerically through home cells. Their pastors had been frequently advised to concentrate on teaching believers to live in the righteousness that only our Lord Jesus can give to believers; they needed all the time to live holy as heaven remains the ultimate for genuine believers. All evidence showed they are on tract.

**Thanksgiving Service.**

One of the other notable events: was the inauguration of a yearly 3-day thanksgiving service. However, this year's service in lieu of that was only for n day, .27<sup>th</sup> November 2021, being the inception. We also had good Christmas Carols and Hymnals for Christmas 2021, and on the 28<sup>th</sup> of December while praying the Lord said the Year 2022 is the year of glory 31<sup>st</sup> December 2021, New Year's Eve was awesome, as the Lord instructed us to anoint everyone into the New Year 2022. Every believer in the service was led into rededicating themselves to the Lord. We are very grateful to God for His faithfulness to keep us standing; despite the pandemic constraints of Covid-19, the ministry is growing stronger than ever, spiritually and materially.
