PRAISE CHRISTIAN CENTRE INTERNATIONAL

Praise Christian Centre International (PCCI) is committed to enabling as many people as possible to worship in our churches and to become part of our extended family. PCCI maintains an overview of worship throughout its assemblies and makes suggestions on how services can involve the many groups that live within our assemblies. Our services and worship are put into practice through prayer and scripture, music and testimonies. When planning yearly activities, the Pastors and board of directors have considered the commission's guidance on public benefit and in particular, the specific guidance on charities for the advancement of religion. We try and enable ordinary people to express their faith as part of the community through Worship and Prayer, Provision of Pastoral care for the people living within the community, Missionary and outreach work Worship and Prayer.

At PCCI we are keen to offer a range of services during the week and over the course of the year that our community find both beneficial and spiritually fulfilling. Our services care for all age groups with programmes to suit families and individuals, with vibrant worship and relevant teaching. In our Sunday Services we aim to provide practical, bible based teachings that equip individuals with skills that are transferrable into everyday experiences as the Bible's timeless truths are brought to life. We love to worship our God in smaller group meetings which provide an intimate and reflective environment for bible study whilst opportunities are given to people to engage into discussion and share testimonies.

This year we have been successful in welcoming more members in our assemblies. All are welcome to attend our regular services and home cell groups. Services have been predominantly held online since the beginning of the pandemic. The average weekly attendance is estimated to be 60 but this number fluctuates and also increases when we have conferences and events. As well as our regular service, we enable our community to celebrate and thank God at the milestone of the journey through life. In marriage, public vows are exchanged with Gods blessings. PCCI also has an established couples ministry to celebrate the institution of marriage and to provide a platform where practical answers can be provided in this vital area of life. So whether married, re-married, engaged or in a relationship that is headed towards marriage, our meetings create a great opportunity for members to learn key lessons that help marriage become the wonderful union that it was originally designed by God to be.

Pastoral Care: Due to the pandemic, we have not been able to hold services in person and have had virtual meetings instead. Our Pastors have visited all members who have requested a visit. This has helped members who are unable to attend service for any reason to keep in touch with church life. Our offices are open for any assistance that people in the

community may need. In addition, our Pastors have opened their homes to church members to visit for a word of encouragement.

Missions and Evangelism: The ministry has continued to feed the homeless through the winter hot meals project. The project began in December 2011 and runs from December to March targeting minority groups in the Middlesbrough Community. We also provide information about other charity organisations that help in poverty alleviation. This project has been made possible by the unwavering support of the PCCI volunteers, Middlesbrough Council and other partners from the Middlesbrough Affordable Warmth group. We also run a programme carried out by male volunteers to provide free gardening to people who are unable to do their own gardening. Women in the church have previously volunteered in care homes around Middlesbrough to provide cleaning services. We aim to continue helping in our communities as this is in line with our faith as followers of Christ.

Volunteers: We would like to thank our volunteers who work hard to make the church a lively, vibrant community. In particular, we want to mention the music team who have worked tirelessly to provide an atmosphere of worship during our services. Our Senior Pastor Veronica Nyarambi for her guidance and prayers and all the members of PCCI for their valuable contribution to the ministry and for keeping the church running.

Administrative Information: PCCI has 4 Assemblies across England. This includes Bolton, Sheffield, Southend and Middlesbrough. The board of directors are responsible for decision making on all matters of general concern and importance to all assemblies. All our assemblies are run under the direct leadership of the appointed Pastors. Local Pastors have appointed committees which include Praise and Worship teams, mission and outreach team and finance teams. Local Pastors are required to report back to the directors regularly.
