

Our apostolate to the needy, poor, and vulnerable brethren of our society went almost to its peak since after our last report. The Sisters of the needy, and all their collaborators through our apostolate over this ending financial year have rehabilitated more than 20 people. Some with varied addictive behaviours, substance abuse issues, relational, and crisis pregnancy were helped accordingly.
