- **Weekly Prayers:** The church has held weekly online bible studies where members aim to learn and understand the gospel. Bible studies have proven very popular as it affords an opportunity to socialise and interact. This is open to all members of the community with time and venue advertised on the church website.
- **Monthly all-night online prayers and service:** The all night prayers are held on the last Saturday of every month. The attendance to these averages 80 as it is an opportunity for those who are otherwise tied up on Sundays to attend. Delegates come from as far as Northampton and Peterborough.



- Ran a dedicated prayer lines to provide support and assistance to Covid affected families in the community and this has continued.


