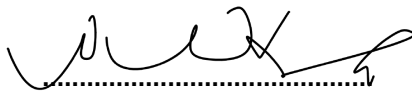

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of preparing the financial statements

The financial statements have been prepared under historical cost convention and in accordance with the Statement of Recommended Practice - Accounting and Reporting by Charities (SORP 2005) issued in March 2005 and applicable accounting policies adopted in the preparation of the financial statements are as follows:

Accounting convention

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention, with the exception of investments which are included at market value, the Charities Act 2011 and the requirements of the Statement of Recommended Practice, Accounting and Reporting by Charities.

Financial reporting standard number 1

Exemption has been taken from preparing a cash flow statement on the grounds that the charity qualifies as a small charity.

Incoming resources

All incoming resources are included on the Statement of Financial Activities when the charity is legally entitled to the income and the amount can be quantified with reasonable accuracy.

Tithes & Offerings

Income from tithes and offerings, is included in incoming resources when these are receivable

Investment Income

Investment income consists of net interest received during the year and accounted for as unrestricted fund.

Resources expended

Expenditure is accounted for on an accruals basis and has been classified under headings that aggregate all cost related to the category. Where costs cannot be directly attributed to particular headings they have been allocated to activities on a basis consistent with the use of resources.

Charitable activities

Costs of charitable activities are those costs relating to the activities carried out to meet the objectives of the Church. These include both directly attributable costs and apportioned support costs.

Governance costs

Governance costs are the costs associated with the strategic direction of the organisation and with meeting regulatory responsibilities including apportioned support cost.

Tangible fixed assets

Depreciation is provided at the following annual rates in order to write off each asset over its estimated useful life.

Equipment and Furniture	- 20% on cost
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Taxation

The charity is exempt from corporation tax on its charitable activities.

Fund Accounting

Unrestricted funds is used in accordance with the charitable objectives at the discretion of the trustees.

Restricted funds can only be used for particular restricted purposes within the objects of the charity. Restrictions arise when specified by the donor or when funds are raised for particular restricted purposes.

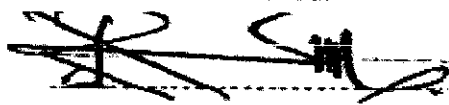

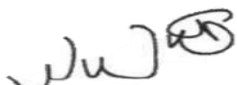

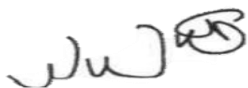

Under the Common Purposes Agreement (see above) Eagles Christian Connections has agreed to make an annual contribution to RCCG (UK). In addition, the church supports missionary organisations such as the World Evangelism Mission.

The church also provides support to members of the congregation (at the discretion of the trustees) who are in need.

Volunteers

We take this opportunity to thank all our volunteers who work so diligently, committing time and energy as well as other resources financial or otherwise to make our church relevant in the community.

ACHIEVEMENTS AND PERFORMANCE

THE SOARING WOMEN CONFERENCE - 11-12 July 2020

This conference sought to empower our women in a time of national crisis. It encouraged the women of the church and society to rise up and help their families to meet the challenges arising from covid-19. As they soar they will assist their families to seek God's assistance to take them through this period of national uncertainty.

YOUTH LED WORSHIP SERVICE : EXPERIENCE - July 2020

An interactive online, wholistic worship, discussion and prayer session. This was a youth and young people ministry program (The lively stones), geared towards inspiring the youths to worship, praise and voice their opinions on issues relevant to them and our times.

MENS RETREAT 2020 - The Faithful Man - 1st August 2020

The event was organised, so that men could take a step back from the day to day life. It was a period of relaxation, dialogue, critical thinking, short and long-term planning for our men to meet the future.

EAGLE CHRISTIAN CONVENTION AND ANIVERSARY - 20th September 2020

We celebrated our anniversary in conjunction with the annual convention. This event inspired us to rise up, live for Christ and share our blessing with the world. It represented a time of awakening, empowerment and putting Christ at the centre of our lives.

THE IRREVERSIBLE VICTORY - 24th October 2020

This was our women's 2020 virtual retreat designed to inspire, encourage, renew and refresh our walk with the Lord. The ladies filled the day with praise, working and activities centred around our Lord.

CROSS OVER NIGHT - EXTRAORDINARY - 31st December 2020

STATEMENT OF TRUSTEES RESPONSIBILITIES

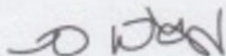

As the charity's trustees, you are responsible for the preparation of the accounts in accordance with the requirements of the Charities Act 2011.

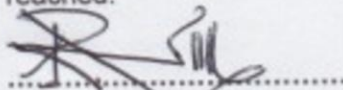

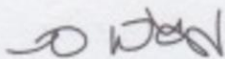

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of preparing the financial statements

The financial statements have been prepared under historical cost convention and in accordance with the Statement of Recommended Practice - Accounting and Reporting by Charities (SORP 2005) issued in March 2005 and applicable accounting policies adopted in the preparation of the financial statements are as follows:

Accounting convention

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention, with the exception of investments which are included at market value, the Charities Act 2011 and the requirements of the Statement of Recommended Practice, Accounting and Reporting by Charities.

Financial reporting standard number 1

Exemption has been taken from preparing a cash flow statement on the grounds that the charity qualifies as a small charity.

Incoming resources

All incoming resources are included on the Statement of Financial Activities when the charity is legally entitled to the income and the amount can be quantified with reasonable accuracy.

Tithes & Offerings

Income from tithes and offerings, is included in incoming resources when these are receivable

Investment Income

Investment income consists of net interest received during the year and accounted for as unrestricted fund.

Resources expended

Expenditure is accounted for on an accruals basis and has been classified under headings that aggregate all cost related to the category. Where costs cannot be directly attributed to particular headings they have been allocated to activities on a basis consistent with the use of resources.

Charitable activities

Costs of charitable activities are those costs relating to the activities carried out to meet the objectives of the Church. These include both directly attributable costs and apportioned support costs.

Governance costs

Governance costs are the costs associated with the strategic direction of the organisation and with meeting regulatory responsibilities including apportioned support cost.

Tangible fixed assets

Depreciation is provided at the following annual rates in order to write off each asset over its estimated useful life.

Equipment and Furniture	- 25% on cost
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Taxation

The charity is exempt from corporation tax on its charitable activities.

Fund Accounting

Unrestricted funds is used in accordance with the charitable objectives at the discretion of the trustees.

Restricted funds can only be used for particular restricted purposes within the objects of the charity. Restrictions arise when specified by the donor or when funds are raised for particular restricted purposes.
