Para 1.17 and 1.19	<p>Supporting in the education and welfare at Mgutwa Secondary and High School in the Maasai Steppe of Tanzania.</p> <p>As the Trust helps provide for the needs of the students, the burden of the parents and caregivers is lightened, as they know their child is being fed, educated and cared for in a safe environment.</p> <p>Due to drought and flood conditions food is scarce, as is work, leading to lack of basic provisions for the family. Many young people are sent away to work or are being married, to alleviate this burden.</p> <p>The Trust enables these young people at Mgutwa to be educated, giving them a chance to have a fulfilled future and higher education. In turn, returning to their communities, providing knowledge and hope for the future.</p>

Providing for the students and staff is essential to keep the school open and functioning.</p> <p>The biogas system is fully functional and has encouraged the students and local community to be more aware of their</p>

The Trust provided funding to purchase maize, beans, rice, the staple for the school residence. This donation enabled the students and staff to continue at the school. Wages Provision for the wages was supported by the trust for Mgutwa School. The staff, who mostly reside at the school during term time are: teachers, reception and office staff, security, farm and maintenance workers, cooks and healthcare employees. The school provides work and experience for those employed. The wider communities in the area have observed the workers and have had confidence to branch out in small businesses, taking an opportunity to be educated and see their offspring being educated.

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



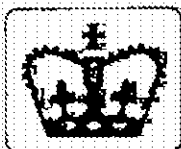
