REPORT OF THE TRUSTEES
for the year ended 31st October 2024

The trustees who are also directors of the charity for the purposes of the Companies Act 2006, present their report with the financial statements of the charity for the year ended 31st October 2024. The trustees have adopted the provisions of Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2019).

OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

Objectives and aims

Our memorandum of Association states:

"The charity's objects are 1. To advance the Christian religion for the benefit of the public by teaching, holding public services of worship, and producing and distributing literature to enlighten others about Christianity. 2. To relieve need, hardship, and physical and mental distress among all persons without limitation."

As a church we are grateful to God for His kindness and faithfulness to us. Here is a summary of our encouragements, blessings and challenges at October 2023.

Congregation and Session (Leadership)

We continue our weekly public meetings on Sunday morning, open to anyone in the community, where we gather for worship, instruction in the Christian faith, and extended time for informal discussion over refreshments, fellowship and a shared lunch. We have been glad to welcome a steady stream of visitors and new people, across a wide range of ages and cultural backgrounds.

We have a stable and committed leadership of three elders and an assistant pastor, and this has shown itself in the way we have been able to work together as leaders. The congregation has grown gradually from local people.

Our midweek bible study has been very well attended as we meet in three local groups.

Denomination We have completed the final stages of joining the International Presbyterian Church, UK presbytery.

Outreach.

- **Door to Door visiting** of the local neighbourhood has enabled us to get to know local people and their needs.
- **Street Carols.** Outdoor street carol singing has been a very effective way to gather larger numbers of neighbours for singing and a short presentation.
- **The Easter Feast** is a great opportunity to invite new people to church.

"Raising Expectations" Conference.

We were greatly encouraged by our conference attendance this year (150 attendees), and our speaker was Dr. Timothy Edwards, along with Pr. Steve Hayhow.

Arts Workshop We held our first arts workshop in September with artist and photographer, Sylvester Jacobs. About 25 artists and those interested in pursuing a vocation in the arts, spent the day together.

OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

Young People

We have begun a monthly teenager's meeting. In addition we continued collaboration with Chelmsford Presbyterian Church for *The 18-30s* group gathering people from a range of churches.

Oak Hill Student Placement.

We have two student placement from *Oak Hill College*. A family who are preparing to become missionaries and are with us for another year whilst they train. We have another family who are training for church work. It is a privilege to support them and participation in the church and training.

Women's Mentoring

A ladies meeting continues with Kristine Hayhow who has completed her training with BCUK.

Psalm Roar We have been encouraged in our singing through the concerted efforts of our musicians to train us to be better singers. In January we held a singing day where members and others from outside our congregation spent the day learning new music and improving our singing.

FINANCIAL REVIEW

Principal funding sources

The main sources of income derive from donations of members and supporters. Donations for the year increased to £150,252 (compared to £98,383 in 2023) and total resources expended were £126,594 (compared to £86,872 in 2022).

Reserves policy

The Unrestricted Fund represents the free reserves of the charity. The Unrestricted Fund balance was £72,369 at 31st October 2024, providing the ability to have sensible buffer to cover fluctuations in giving and to start to build a fund to expand our work in the coming years. The restricted fund represents the reserves available to assist those in financial difficulty. The Restricted Fund balance was £2,000 at 31st October 2024.

STRUCTURE, GOVERNANCE AND MANAGEMENT

Governing document

The charity is controlled by its governing document, a deed of trust, and constitutes a limited company, limited by guarantee, as defined by the Companies Act 2006.

Our memorandum of Association states:

"The charity's objects are 1. To advance the Christian religion for the benefit of the public by teaching, holding public services of worship, and producing and distributing literature to enlighten others about Christianity. 2. To relieve need, hardship, and physical and mental distress among all persons without limitation."

Emmanuel Evangelical Church is organised as a limited company.

New trustees are appointed or stand down by trustee vote, which is recorded in the minutes. New trustees have been selected due to their relationship to the congregation, and are of good character.

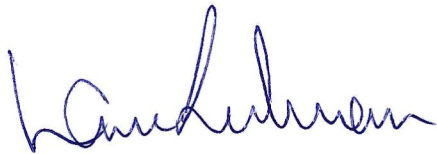

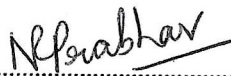

NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of preparing the financial statements

The financial statements of the charitable company, which is a public benefit entity under FRS 102, have been prepared in accordance with the Charities SORP (FRS 102) 'Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2019)', Financial Reporting Standard 102 'The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland' and the Companies Act 2006. The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

Income

All income is recognised in the Statement of Financial Activities once the charity has entitlement to the funds, it is probable that the income will be received and the amount can be measured reliably.

Expenditure

Liabilities are recognised as expenditure as soon as there is a legal or constructive obligation committing the charity to that expenditure, it is probable that a transfer of economic benefits will be required in settlement and the amount of the obligation can be measured reliably. Expenditure is accounted for on an accruals basis and has been classified under headings that aggregate all cost related to the category. Where costs cannot be directly attributed to particular headings they have been allocated to activities on a basis consistent with the use of resources.

Taxation

The charity is exempt from corporation tax on its charitable activities.

Fund accounting

Unrestricted funds can be used in accordance with the charitable objectives at the discretion of the trustees.

Restricted funds can only be used for particular restricted purposes within the objects of the charity. Restrictions arise when specified by the donor or when funds are raised for particular restricted purposes.

Further explanation of the nature and purpose of each fund is included in the notes to the financial statements.

Pension costs and other post-retirement benefits

The charitable company operates a defined contribution pension scheme. Contributions payable to the charitable company's pension scheme are charged to the Statement of Financial Activities in the period to which they relate.

2. TRUSTEES' REMUNERATION AND BENEFITS

During the financial year ended 31st October 2024, the church provided housing assistance to certain employees as part of their total compensation package. This assistance was in the form of rent payments made directly by the church on behalf of the employees.

The total amount expended on employee housing and rent during the year was £36,600. These payments were made in accordance with the church's approved employment and compensation policies and are considered part of the overall remuneration for the respective employees.

This practice is intended to support clergy and staff who are required to reside in proximity to the church or otherwise fulfill housing requirements necessary for the execution of their duties. All such arrangements are documented, approved by the church leadership/board, and reported as taxable benefits in compliance with applicable tax regulations.

There were no trustees' remuneration or other benefits for the year ended 31st October 2023.
