Over the course of the 2021/2 financial year, the Trust granted £26,678 to the Tanzania Forest Conservation (TFCG) group, a registered society in Tanzania, for projects which include the objects above, specifically:

1. (a) Environmental education in impoverished, isolated villages in Tanzania
2. (b) Grass roots community development in impoverished, isolated villages in Tanzania
3. (c) Protection of natural rainforests in isolated areas of Tanzania

The TFCG reports regularly to the African Rainforest Trust and makes available financial audits at the request of the Trust.

When considering a grant request, the Trust evaluates the proposal against the objectives of the Trust Deed, including their adherence to the principle of the public benefit.

Therefore, the Trustees declare that the Trust has abided by the guidance issued by the Charity Commission on public benefit.

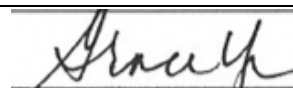
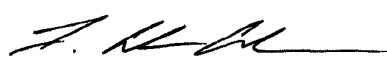

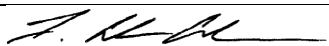
