All gutters fall pipes and the valley between the Sanctuary and Lady Chapel are cleaned out twice each year.

We continue to support the people of Swinton in their joys and sorrows of life. This means the number of occasional Officers conducted by Fr. Chris has been high again this year.

We continue to use the Church building for more community events e.g. monthly coffee mornings concerts and fairest. We also had our second beer festival this year

Which was a great success, we are planning a repeat of this event in the summer of 2026.

We are planning to build a Community Hall on the corner of the church field our

Architect is now working out a programme for the building of the hall next year now that our funding target has now been reached.

Parish outings are still very much attended which brings the community together.

AUDIT NOTES :

The summary of the movement in Cash Funds shows a total increase of **£10,890**, the following comments should explain this within the various Funds :

Curates Property - This fund has increased by **£15,006** mainly due to the new fence was paid out in 2021 at a cost of £5898 and in this last year £5220 was transferred from the General Fund. There were also payments last year of £ £1506 for J Beentliff salary and Architects Fees of £ £1992, the only item of expenditure this last year is the property Insurance.

The Organ Fund shows an increase of **£ 159** during the year being interest credited to the account of £217 and the balance of ££58 in the old Yorkshire Bank Account closed and transferred into the General Fund

The Church Hall Fund has increased by **£10,900**, there was a transfer of £10,000 from the General Fund, Donations of £2785 less Architects Fees of £1884.

The Churchyard Fund showed an overall decrease of **£ 20,172** within the year, the bulk of this was the cost of the work on the Paths, New Gates , Architects Fees.

The General Fund shows an increase over last year of **£4,996** , the planned giving was slightly more than the previous year but the general giving was £2,000 less, however the Income Tax Claimed was £1,200 more which levelled the total giving overall to be a little more than 2021 The amount given to the Diocese Common Fund was £20,000 which was £5,000 more than last year, but with the increase in PCC Fees, the closure of the three old Yorkshire bank accounts and Interest on Investments of £3,000 this enabled the increase of £4,996 to be achieved at the end of 2022.

The summary of the movement in Cash Funds shows a total decrease in the year of **£2688**, the following comments should explain this within the various Funds :

Curates Property - This fund has only decreased by £115 during the year , the rental income was very similar to 2020, and enabled payment for fence replacement , architects fees, ash tree attention and part of salary for J Bentliffe.

The Organ Fund shows a small increase of £9 during the year.

The Church Hall Fund has decreased by £ £2184.. due to payment of Architects Fees;

The Churchyard Fund showed an overall decrease of £5218 as a result of purchasing equipment to the value of £7200

The General Fund shows an increase over last year of **£4,800** ,
Income did benefit from the following :

Planned Giving similar to 2000, but Collections increased by £8,300
Fundraising had re-commenced which amounted to £6,300, includes the Bonfire Party
However Income from Tax recovered was £3,300 less than 2020
We also benefitted by there being less costs on major fabric items this last year.

Additional Expenses this last year:

Heat, light & water was £2,000 greater than 2020
Organist Fees were £2,000 more than 2020
We were able to pay the Diocese £5,000 more in Common Fund

Overall the Church is showing signs of moving forward with re-introducing fundraising activities, as with all investments interest rates are not doing too well which is reflected in the investment income, but we still expect further increases with the projected increase in cost of utilities which I'm sure will be monitored during the next few months, as always I must comment on the important work carried out by Jean supported by Jennifer and I'm sure that the PCC appreciate all their efforts together with many other church members who carry our various important duties..

AUDIT NOTES :

The summary of the movement in Cash Funds shows a total increase of **£11,061**, the following comments should explain this within the various Funds :

Curates Property - This fund has only decreased by £73 during the year having transferred £5,000 to the Churchyard fund .

The Organ Fund shows an increase of £ 70 during the year being interest credited to the account, the annual organ tuning costs of £170 was paid out of the General Fund.

The Church Hall Fund remains the same figure of £3190 being no movement during the year..

The Churchyard Fund showed an overall increase of £ 8,900 within the year, there was a transfer of £5,000 from the Property Fund,, increase in PCC Ashes Fee of £3,000, there was also an increase in grave digging fees of £3,000 but the same amount was spent in the cost of grave digging.

The General Fund shows an increase over last year of **£2,150** , however the main loss in income is attributed to ;
