The Trustees have assessed the major risks to which the church is exposed, in particular those related to the operations and finances of the church and are satisfied that systems are in place to mitigate our exposure to the major risks.

All these events enabled parishioners to develop their Christian Faith and enhances personal developments. Parishioners made personal progress in life through personal interactions, and they developed interpersonal skills that enabled them to gain the relevant confidence to make an impact in the wider world.

Conferences and Special Events

The church held special events that addressed current issues that the community faces. These meetings were opened to the public and focused on different demographical groups. We pray and preach the good news of salvation not only in Essex but in many other parts of the UK.

Music

Music is at the core of our events. We understand the importance of music to parishioners as it helps build spiritual development and interpersonal relationship. So, we organized Musical events from time to time.

The trustees have decided that at present, funds should be retained in Bank. Any change in such banking arrangements should be agreed by the board of trustees. As far as possible, funds will be retained in interest bearing accounts.

c. Grant making policies

As a Parish of the Redeemed Christian Church of God), Triumphant Christian Connections has agreed to make an annual contribution to RCCG (UK). The church also provides support to members of the congregation (at the discretion of the trustees) who are in need.

d. Volunteers

The church is grateful for the immense contributions and efforts of its volunteers who are involved in provision and delivery of Services and administration.

FINANCIAL REVIEW

a. Reserves policy

The Trustees have established a policy whereby the unrestricted funds not committed or invested in tangible fixed assets ('the free reserves') held by the church should be 3 months of annual expenditure. At this level, the trustees feel that they would be able to continue the current activities of the church in the event of a significant drop in funding.

PLANS FOR FUTURE PERIODS

a. Future developments

We are seeking to obtain a lease or outright purchase of a permanent place of worship which will also be used as a Christian Worship and Community Centre. This will enable us to carry out wide range of faith based community activities that we are unable to do currently for the reason of restricted accommodation.

The law applicable to charities in England and Wales requires the Trustees to prepare financial statements for each financial year which give a true and fair view of the situation of the charity and of the incoming resources and application of resources of the charity for that period. In preparing these financial statements, the Trustees are required to:

- select suitable accounting policies and then apply them consistently;
- observe the methods and principles in the Charities SORP;
- make judgements and estimates that are reasonable and prudent;
- state whether applicable accounting standards have been followed, subject to any material departures disclosed and explained in the financial statements;

The Trustees are also responsible for safeguarding the assets of the charity and hence for taking reasonable steps for the prevention and detection of fraud and other irregularities.

Music

b. Investment policy and performance

The trustees have decided that at present, funds should be retained in Bank. Any change in such banking arrangements should be agreed by the board. As far as possible, funds will be retained in interest bearing accounts.

c. Grant making policies

As a Parish of the Redeemed Christian Church of God), Triumphant Christian Connections has agreed to make an annual contribution to RCCG (UK). The church also provides support to members of the congregation (at the discretion of the trustees) who are in need.

1. Accounting Policies

1.1. Basis of Preparation of Financial Statements

a. Accounting Convention

The financial statements are prepared under the historical cost convention. In preparing the financial statements, the charity follows the best practice as laid down in the Statement of Recommended Practice 'Accounting and Reporting by Charities' (SORP 2000) issued in October 2000.

To comply fully with the statement of Recommended Practice, would require investments to be accounted for at valuation. The trustees believe since the investments are held for the long term, it would be inappropriate to account for unrealised gains and losses for the period. 1. Accounting Policies

1.1. Basis of Preparation of Financial Statements

a) Accounting Convention

The financial statements are prepared under the historical cost convention. In preparing the financial statements, the charity follows the best practice as laid down in the Statement of Recommended Practice 'Accounting and Reporting by Charities' (SORP 2000) issued in October 2000.

To comply fully with the statement of Recommended Practice, would require investments to be accounted for at valuation. The trustees believe since the investments are held for the long term, it would be inappropriate to account for unrealised gains and losses for the period. Therefore, investments have been accounted for at historical cost. This is the only exception to compliance with the Statement of Recommended Practice. The market value of the investments is disclosed.

1.2. Turnover

- a) Income from members is credited to the income in the year in which it is receivable by the association. All other income is credited to income in the year in which it is received on a cash basis.
- b) Donations to other charities are charged in the year when the offer is conveyed to the recipients except in the cases of where the offer is conveyed to the recipients except in those cases where the offer is conditioning, such as donations or grants being recognised as expenditures when the conditions attached are fulfilled.
- c) Unrestricted funds are general funds which are available for use at the discretion of the trustees in furtherance of the general objectives of the association and which have not been designated for other purposes.

1.3. Tangible Fixed Assets and Depreciation

The tangible assets are stated at cost less depreciation. The general policy is to provide depreciation on fixed assets on a reducing balance method over their estimated useful lives. No depreciation is charged in the year in which the assets are sold or scrapped.
