**Principal activities**

The charity's principal activity during the year continued to be the advancement of the Christian faith worldwide in accordance with the doctrine set out in the Statement of faith of our trust deed and the relief of poverty to those at risk amongst the general public.

**Organisation structure, governance and management**

The pastor in charge is responsible for the day to day activities of the charity. The pastor liaises with the board of trustees, when they meet to review the activities of the organisation.

**Related party relationship**

RCCG Faith Foundation Fellowship Centre is a member of the Redeemed Christian Church of God (RCCG), which has parishes in the UK and Worldwide. This relationship is governed by an agreement of common purposes. RCCG Faith Foundation Fellowship Centre made regular contribution to RCCG UK for common purposes.

**Risk management**

The trustees have assessed the major risks to which the church is exposed to, in particular those relating to our operations and finances of the church and are satisfied that systems are in place to mitigate exposure to any major risks. In order to safeguard the welfare of Children and young people the Church operates a Child protection policy. All Children's/youth workers are carefully selected and screened and have an enhanced Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) check. They are trained in the safe practice and work within approved guidelines.

**Volunteers**

RCCG Faith Foundation Fellowship Centre is grateful for the immense effort of all its dedicated volunteers who ensure that all our activities are well organised and professionally conducted.

**Financial Review**

The Charity's financial statement for the year ended 31 March 2025 shows a net Surplus of £11,617 (2024: surplus £2,915). Total funds in the year is £30,056 (2024: £18,439).

**Public Benefit**

At RCCG Faith Foundation Fellowship Centre, the trustees ensure that activities are designed in line with the church objects and for the benefit of the general public.



**Year ended 31 March 2025**

**1. Accounting Policy**

The principal accounting policies, all of which have been applied consistently throughout the year, are set out below:

**(a) Scope and basis of the financial statements**

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with The Statement of Recommended Practice: Accounting and Reporting by Charities (SORP 2005) issued in March 2005

**(b) Incoming Resources**

All income is accounted for when the Charity has entitlement to the funds, the amount can be quantified and there is certainty of receipt.

**(c) Resources expended**

All expenditure is accounted for on accrual basis  
Management and administration costs include management of the charity's assets.

**(d) Tangible fixed assets and depreciation**

Tangible fixed assets are stated at cost and depreciated on a straight line basis over their useful economic lives.

The depreciation rates applied, are as follows:

Church Equipment	25%
Furnitures & Fittings	25%
