They have been such a help in the work of the church, and Dixie's help in preparing meals was invaluable. We are also extremely grateful for their generous gift of £15,000 to church funds, both to enable the church to continue, and to help us in our outreach. They will be sorely missed. We are very conscious of the responsibility now placed upon us to achieve the goals of maintaining the presence of the church in the community, and in outreach.

The Trustees are very grateful to Brian Worthington, Secretary of Borrass Park Evangelical Church, for his work in checking our accounts for 2022 - these accounts are now with the Charities Commission. These accounts had been accepted at our Members Meeting of 22.02.23.

We look to the Lord to be with us in the future, to help us in our ministry here in Brynteg, and to build his church. To God alone be the glory.
