This predominantly contributes to medication orders, staff salaries and a hospital charity fund for patients unable to afford treatment charges.</p> <p>Four volunteer doctors and two nurses each spent at least 4 months placement at the hospital. These clinicians supported healthcare delivery and were involved in training of local medical, nursing and anaesthetic staff, as well as the delivery of quality improvement projects at the hospital. This was mutually beneficial and the visiting clinicians gained invaluable experience of medicine and nursing in a challenging and low resource environment.</p>

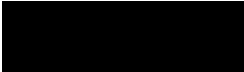
