The difference this work has made to both children and parents mental and physical wellbeing is gratifying and uplifting. We now mentor 100 children, 10 of which are classed as being very vulnerable. We work very closely with Social Services, and the police, on very serious and delicate matters with excellent outcomes. Holiday and breakfast clubs are now operating successfully giving children and parents more good choices.




