STRUCTURE, GOVERNANCE AND MANAGEMENT

Governing document

The charity is controlled by its governing document, a deed of trust, and constitutes a limited company, limited by guarantee, as defined by the Companies Act 2006 on 26th April 2011 with a registered charity number 1137877.

Organisational structure

The nursery is organised such that the day to day running of the nursery has been delegated to the Charity Manager. The Trustees are consulted on all material issues and determine the strategic direction of the charity.
