## Annual Report & Financial Statement

For the Year to 31<sup>st</sup> August 2022

### Annual Report

The Trustees report a busy year that was affected by the ongoing Covid-19 pandemic, which led to fewer visitors and therefore less donations and adoptions. The charity however received two legacies which helped with the lack of funds from other sources.

The sanctuary looks after 19 donkeys, 6 ponies, plus sheep, goats, pigs, rabbits, guinea pigs and other small animals, all of whom have needed a home for one reason or another.

The continual rise in animal feed prices is a concern, in that it could restrict the sanctuary's ability to take in any more animals in need. Donkey feed for instance has more than doubled in price and hay has almost trebled in price over the last 3 years.

We continue to have visits from school groups, so that the pupils can learn about caring for animals. We provide work experience for many school and college students throughout the year. All our volunteers have returned after the Covid-19 lockdowns and carry out an active part in caring for the animals.
