



ANNUAL REPORT FOR 2022

Throughout 2022, Trauma Aid UK (TAUK) has continued to provide training in Eye Movement Desensitisation and Reprocessing (EMDR) to mental health professionals working in traumatised communities worldwide who would not otherwise have access to such training. This has enabled these professionals to acquire professional skills and knowledge in order to alleviate pain and suffering caused by post-traumatic psychological disorders. Due to the Covid pandemic, most of the training this year has been delivered online. This is with the interim agreement of EMDR Europe Association Standards & Training Committee until the end of 2022.

In addition to EMDR Training and providing Continuing Professional Development seminars and workshops online, TAUK has translated a manual for Group EMDR into Arabic which was later used for the purpose of disaster response following the Turkish/Syrian earthquake. Our IT expert, one of the trustees, has developed a computerized organizational system as we move towards encouraging accreditation and local associations. We have made agreements with the EMDR UK Association's regional groups to invite the people we train to attend CPD workshops pro-bono or for non-English speakers, to make available the recording to view with their own interpreter.
