OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

Objectives and aims

The provision of care and support for sick and disabled children living in Israel, in particular, but not exclusively by arranging visits, activities and entertainment for such children.

The relief of stress and distress for sick and disabled children living in Israel and their families, in particular, but not exclusively by arranging volunteer programmes, parties, outings and holidays for such children and their families.

The advancement of such other objects as are for the public benefit and are charitable according to the laws of England and Wales.

ACHIEVEMENT AND PERFORMANCE

The Trustees consider that the performance of the Charity this year has been most adequate. The Trustees are confident that the present level of activity will continue in the foreseeable future.

As the charity trustees of the Trust you are responsible for the preparation of the accounts in accordance with the requirements of the Charities Act 2011 ('the Act').




